RESEARCH METHOD:

Computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI), based on a random sample of mobile phone numbers

GEOGRAPHY OF RESEARCH:

Ukraine excluding AR Crimea and NGCA of Donetska and Luhanska oblasts. The survey does not cover Ukrainians who have moved abroad.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

adult population of Ukraine

SAMPLE SIZE:

1024 respondents. Margin of sample error does not exceed 3,1%.

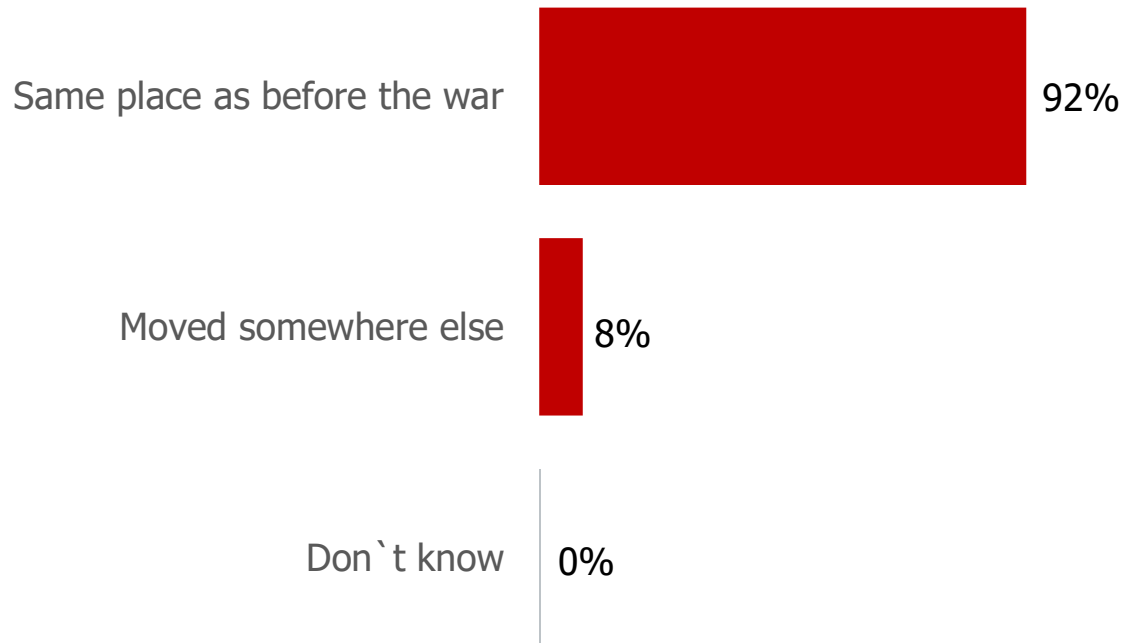
PERIOD OF THE RESEARCH:

Due to the war, some people have left their homes to move somewhere else. Are you currently staying where you were living before the war or have you moved somewhere else?

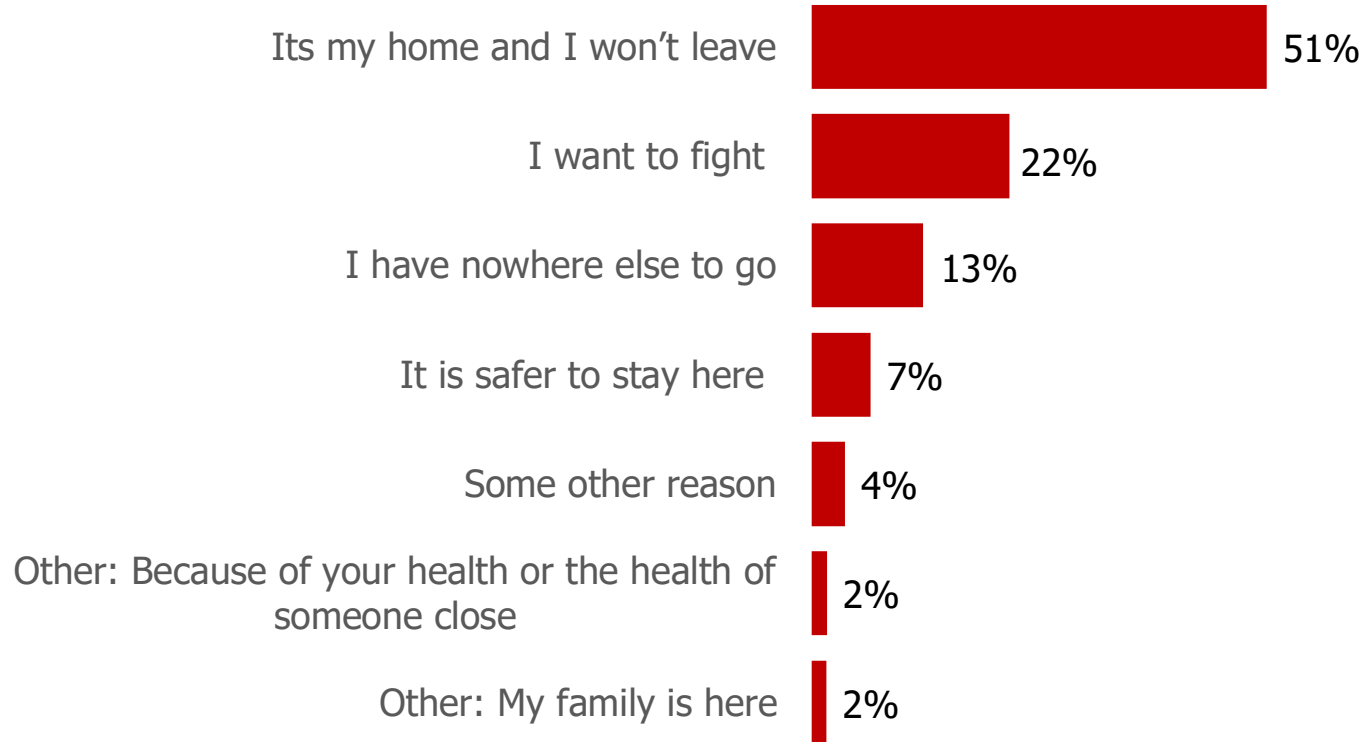

(% those who are at the same place as before the war, N = 937)

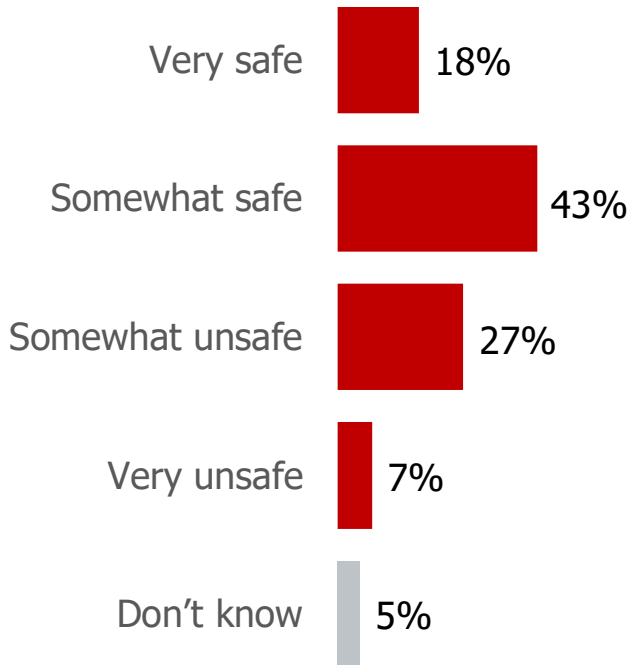


How safe or unsafe do you currently feel during the...

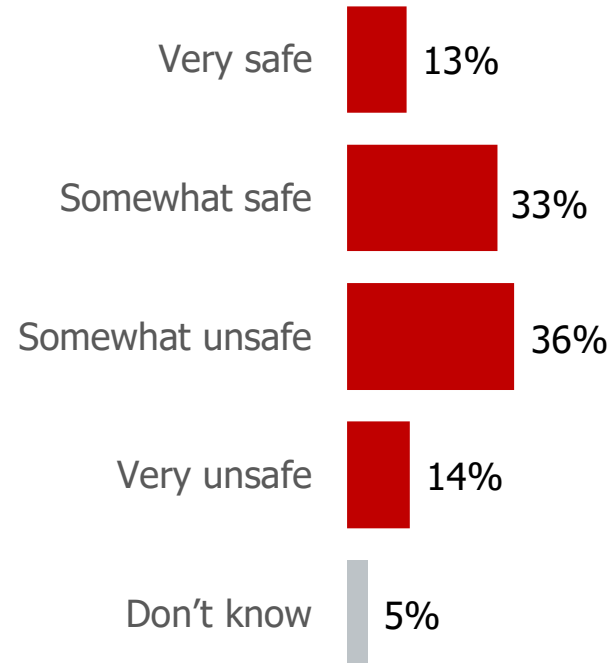

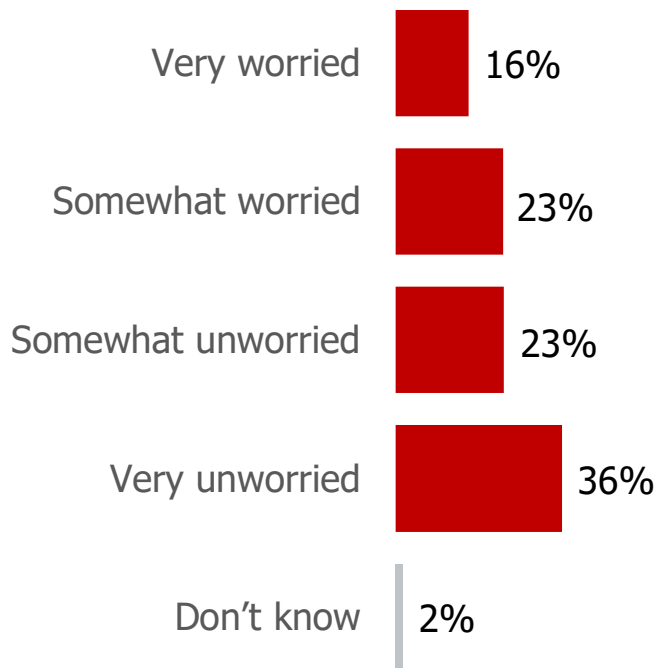


How worried are you about running out of...

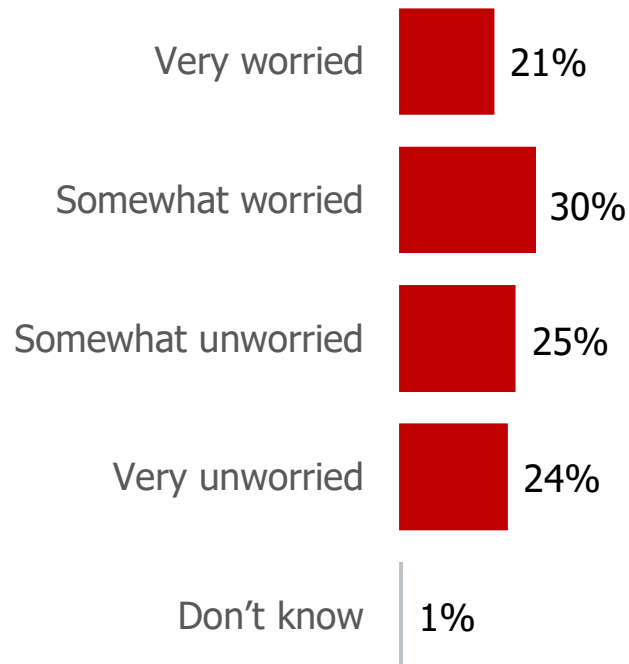

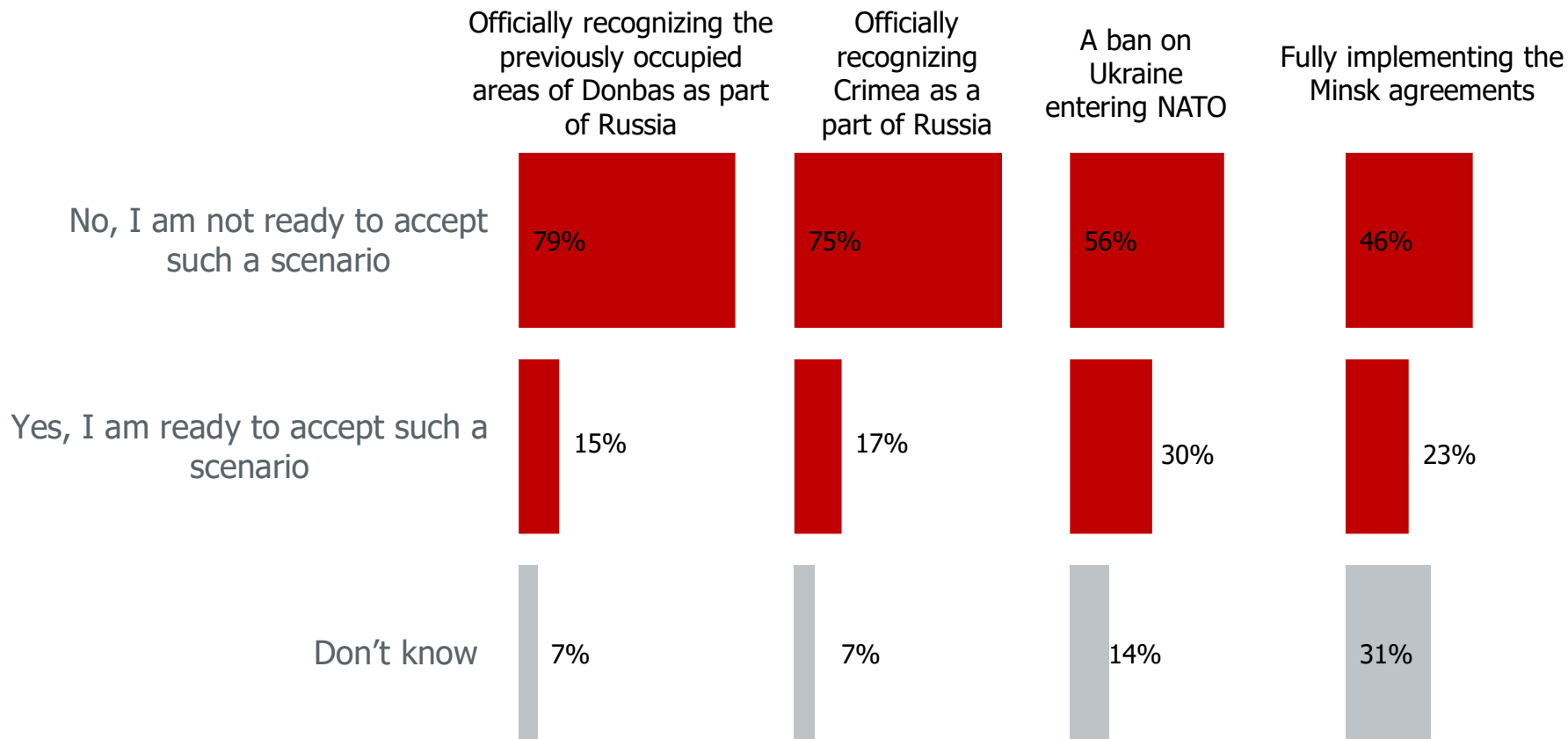

If it guaranteed an immediate end to the war which of the following scenarios, if any, would you be willing to accept, even if reluctantly?



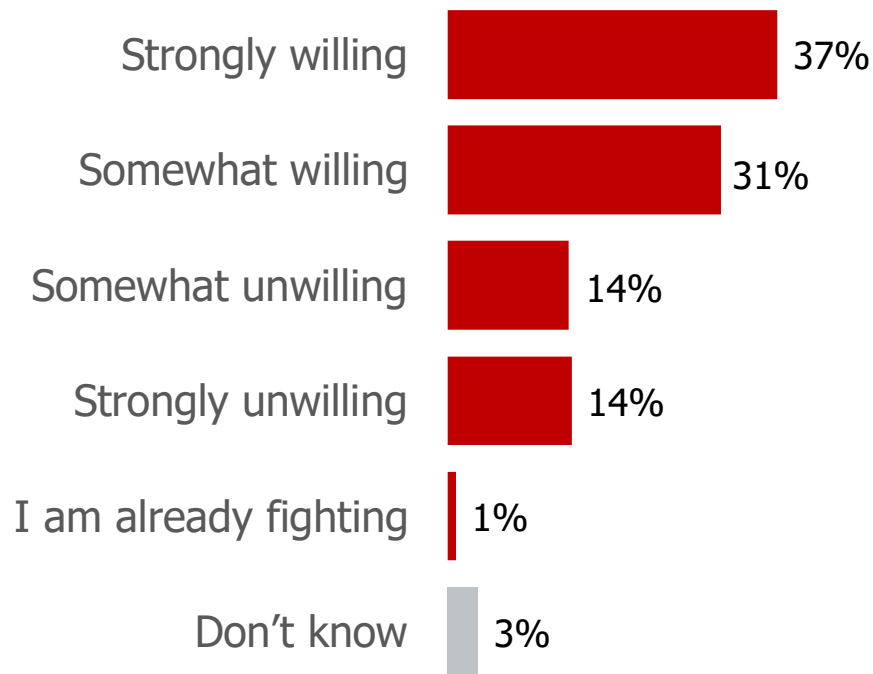

Are you personally willing or not willing to put up armed resistance to stop a Russian occupation of Ukraine?



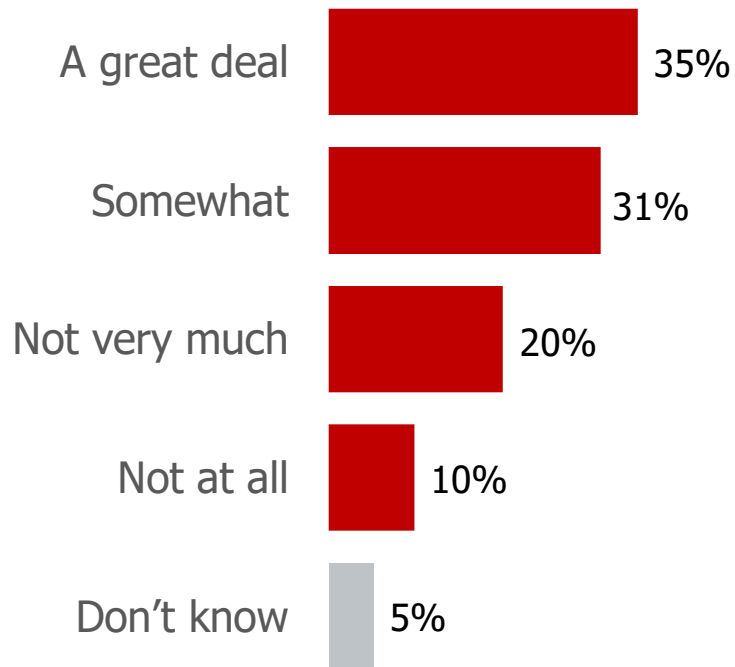
