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Methodology



RESEARCH METHOD:

Computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI), based on a random sample of mobile phone numbers

GEOGRAPHY OF RESEARCH:

Ukraine excluding AR Crimea and NGCA of Donetska and Luhanska oblasts. The survey does not cover Ukrainians who have moved abroad.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

adult population of Ukraine

SAMPLE SIZE:

1st wave: 1024 respondents. Margin of sample error does not exceed 3,1%.

2nd wave: 1032 respondents. Margin of sample error does not exceed 3,1%.

3^d wave: 1033 respondents. Margin of sample error does not exceed 3,1%.

PERIOD OF THE RESEARCH:

1st wave: March 3-4 2022

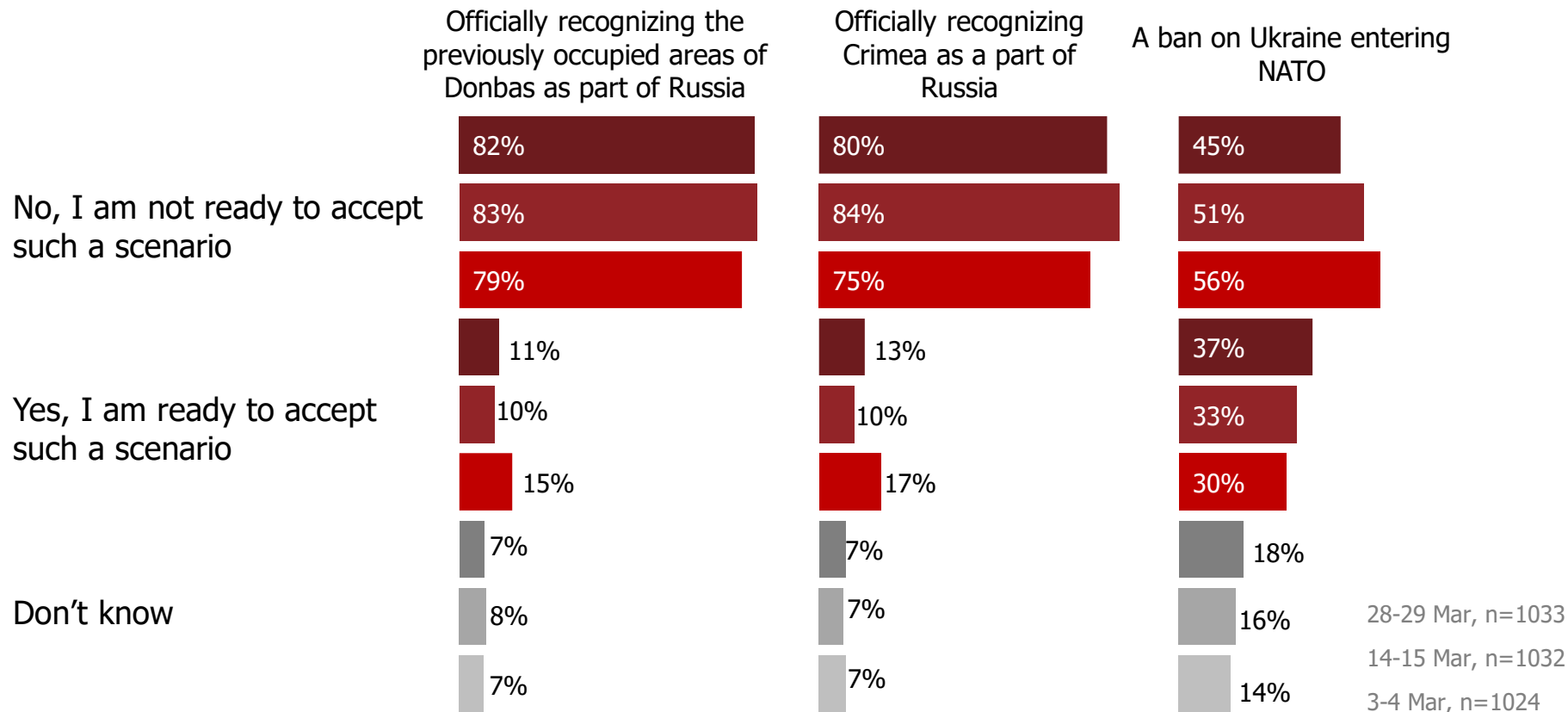
2nd wave: March 14-15 2022

3^d wave: March 28-29 2022

Among all respondents

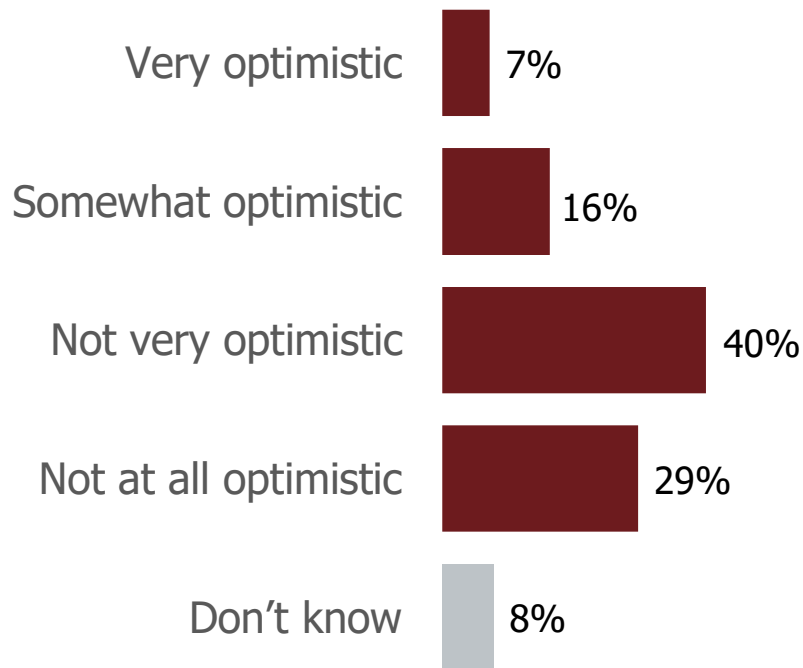


How optimistic are you that the current negotiations between the Ukrainian and Russian governments will help to end the war?

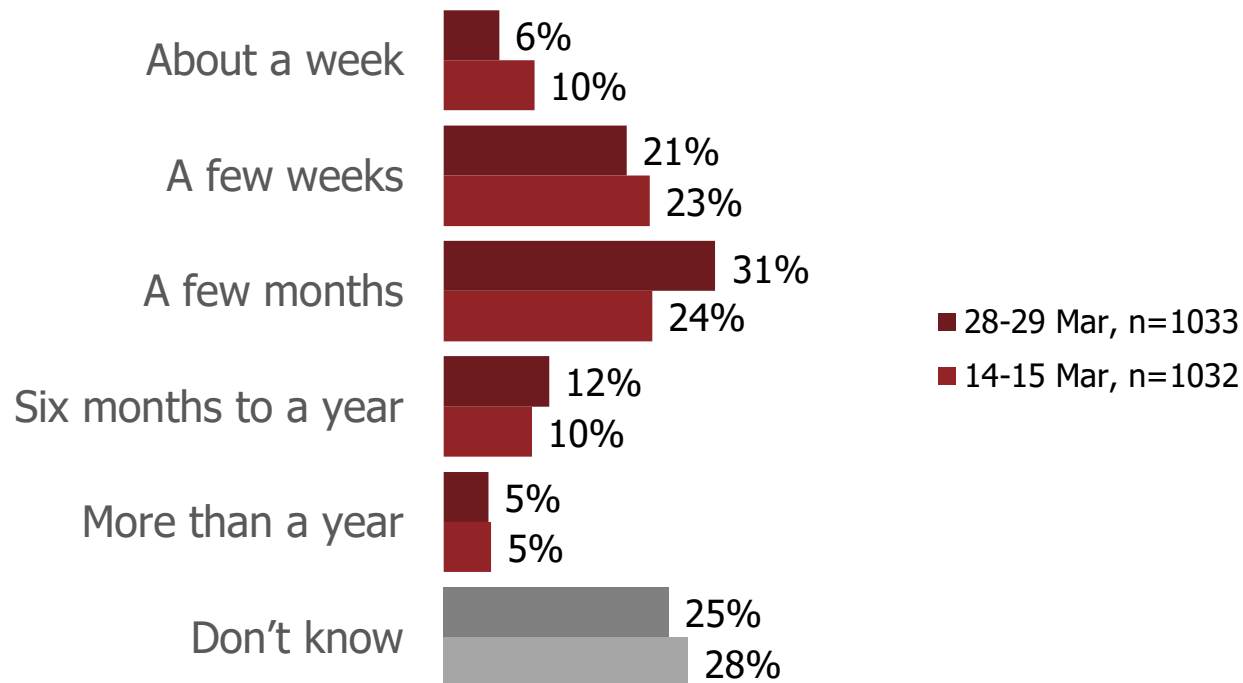
